Creative Delivery and Development

- Coordinate and deliver creative activities such as visual arts, music, creative writing, and more.
- Design sessions that use the creative process as a therapeutic tool.
- Adapt content in line with the needs, interests, and voice of young people.
- Integrate nature-based and outdoor activities in partnership with Eryri National Park.
- Ensure activities promote self-expression, confidence, emotional regulation, and overall wellbeing.

Supporting and Empowering Young People

- Create a safe, supportive, and trauma-informed environment.
- Build positive relationships that encourage trust and participation.
- Enable young people to co-produce and lead elements of the programme.
- Inspire young people to believe in their potential and take advantage of new opportunities.
- Create opportunities to socialise, express concerns, and take part in a range of creative activities.

Collaboration and Partnerships

- Collaborate with the Voice Coordinator and internal teams to amplify young people's voices through creative approaches.
- Ensure the project aligns with Arts Council of Wales priorities, in line with 'Gwneud Synnwyr' grant requirements.
- Work closely with the GISDA Mental Health project (ICAN) to ensure clear and effective referral pathways into therapeutic creative support.
- Integrate nature-based and outdoor approaches in partnership with Eryri National Park.
- Coordinate freelance artists and external partners.
- Develop relationships with arts, health, and community organisations.

Promotion and Marketing

- Continue to develop a strong brand for GISDA Creative.
- Lead promotional activities in collaboration with the GISDA Marketing Coordinator.
- Create marketing materials for social media, the website, and press.
- Ensure compliance with grant promotion requirements and raise public awareness of funders' investment.
